

2022 Executive Director's COVID Safe Program Outline (Welcome Back)

Good day my dear CALE Family, Friends, and to those who wish to join us. I hope that everyone is doing well. Today we endeavor to come to gather safely at our home away from home. COVID has given us pause and many hurdles to navigate, and we have addressed them all together with a shared commitment to protecting everyone who enters our doors... **Our CALE safety steps that we all are taking together in order to keep our good cheer & goodwill intact...**

STEP 1. We hope you appreciate and understand that we can only entertain a **maximum of 11-14 guests safely** at CALE. Therefore, ***we need to REGISTER our folks prior to each event*** with a specific time scheduled with me (Lee Gerardi) in order to keep safe 4-6 Ft-distance for all who enter our doors. **(We are wearing recommended protective MASKS N95, KN95 🤗 or blue Masks, with safety COVID protocols that CALE will respect and honor in accordance with maintaining health and safety policies guided by the Department of Health.)**, Our senior community remains safe and secure.

STEP 2: We have been safely open for our **Tuesday/Thursdays in-house events, since 8/11/20**, with a one to two-three hour programming that ***registered folks can enjoy***. We also have programs that are scheduled every other Monday (Intermediate French) and every other Friday (Painting with Stanley). Please see our **monthly calendars**. Kindly ***inquire with us to come to our programs by arranging registration confirmation and review of our membership and or giving a contribution.***

STEP 3: When entering our CALE, we ask that you ***respectfully sanitize your hands at the front door***, have your **MASK on** prior to entering the building, and **WAIT to be checked-in** with **keeping at proper distancing**, for best health, then you will be shown to your seat.
(If you are not feeling well, then we ask that you cancel your visit till next time.)

STEP 4: **We remain status quo** in April of 2022, in order to keep our doors open with all safe from harm, while coming to a ***scheduled event*** at CALE. A HEALTHY successful endeavor, since **2020**, it is because of our COMMITMENT, DEDICATION and UNITED fronts in keeping all these STEPS respectfully in our **conjoined stride TOGETHER we remain here safely for the community!**
